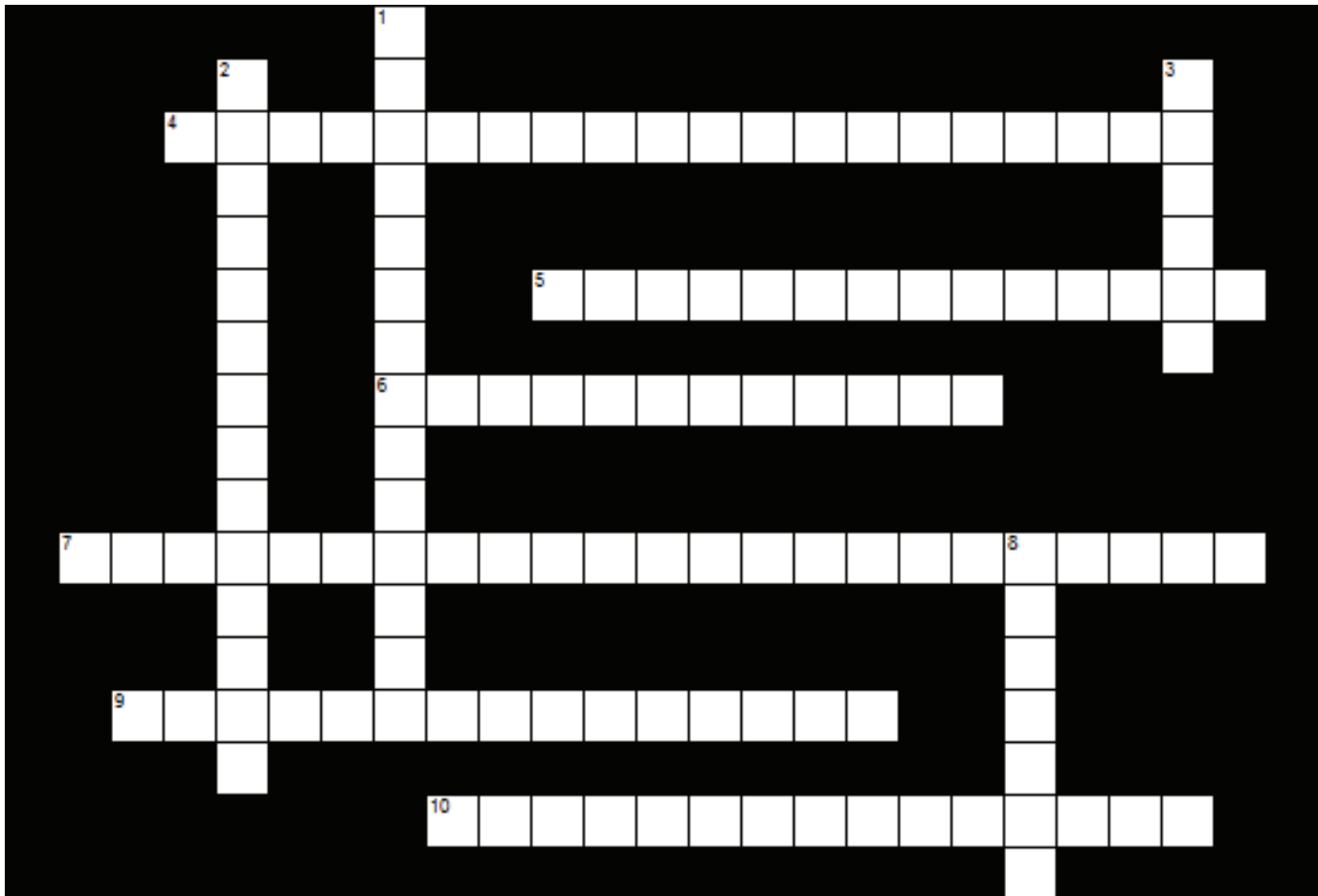


Ethical Practices in Business Finance
