

To Create a PowerPoint from a Website using Brisk:

Say you find a perfect article online that you want to use to teach your students, you can use Brisk to automatically pull the information and make a presentation, a quiz or lesson plan. You just click on the icon on your tool bar after installing. Just a note if you want to get the answers for the quiz, you have to edit the instructions to include "and answers." It can make a hard copy of a quiz or put it into google forms.

Here are the steps to create a PowerPoint:

Be sure your Brisk Chrome extension is installed. You can get it from here - <https://www.briskteaching.com/>.

Find the website with information that you want. I searched for Leadership Styles. I chose this website: <https://corporatefinanceinstitute.com/resources/management/leadership-styles/>

Click on the Chrome Brisk extension icon in the upper right corner. You may have to sign-in at this point.




The Brisk icon will appear at the bottom right of your page. Click it. The Brisk box will appear.



If you choose Presentation, the Presentation options box will appear. Choose grade level and number of slides that you want.




